E Test

Disc Colour: Pale Yellow

Candidate Requirements:

- The E test is a voluntary assessment and is not required to progress to further assessments.
- Candidates should be accompanied by an adult helper. The assessment may be taken on or off the lead rein.

Outcomes:

Candidates should be happy both on and around ponies.

Candidates should know the basic points of the pony.

Format:

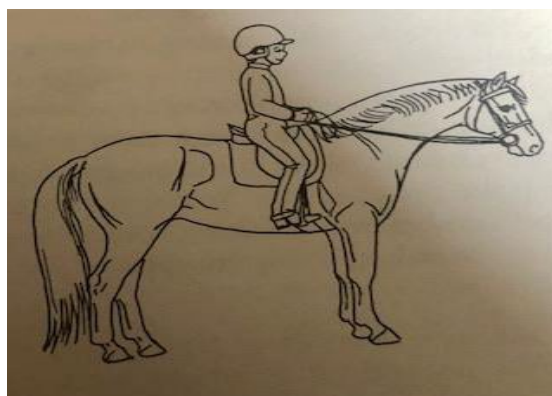
The E test consists of riding in an arena or safe space and basic horse care.

Candidates can wear Pony Club sweatshirt or jumper (no hood), White, beige, plain black or plain navy jodhpurs and a hat. Back protectors are recommended.

Riding:

Candidates should:

- Be able to sit on a pony in halt and at walk
- Be able to hold the reins
- With help, carry out physical exercises such as:
 - Touch parts of the pony (i.e. mane, neck, tail etc)
 - The ability to ride pony away from examiner at walk, turn around a cone and go back to the assessor
 - Be able to show trot (rising is not necessary) on the leading rein
 - Be able to stop at a designated point and say 'thank you'

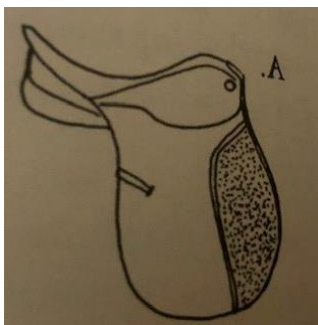


Horse Care:

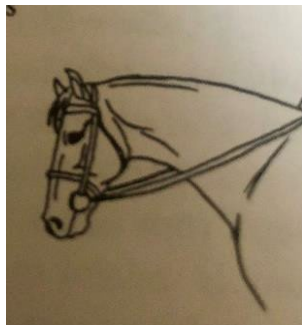
Candidates should be able to:
